RESOLUTION OPPOSING OCEAN OUTFALL AS AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD FOR DISPOSING OF EFFLUENT BY THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA REGIONAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol is a participant of the Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility, and therefore, has a vested interest in the method for disposing of effluent; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sebastopol has a responsibility to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens, and therefore is concerned about the quality and composition of effluent; and

WHEREAS, the continued use of the Laguna de Santa Rosa and the Russian River for legal and/or illegal discharges of effluent pose significant health and environmental risks; and

WHEREAS, there are significant environmental and health risks associated with a wastewater pipeline to the Pacific Ocean and the entire West County, and these negative impacts have not been adequately addressed in the Draft Environmental Impact Report on the long-range wastewater plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Sebastopol strongly opposes the Pacific Ocean Outfall Plan as a method for disposing of effluent.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Sebastopol urges the City of Santa Rosa to specifically investigate the use, costs and feasibility of state-of-the-art tertiary treatment of effluent to-gether with proper reclamation and/or disposal systems and facilities, prior to further action regarding any alternatives of effluent disposal.
