- 4. Review with the Planning Department existing rules, regulations and laws affecting the Laguna to identify any additional regulations or incentives needed for preservation and renovation..
- 5. Review the FEMA maps and make recommendations if any to the B/S on proposed revisions. Fed. Emergency Management Agency -
- 6. Work with the City of Santa Rosa and the City of Sebastopol to promote Laguna protection and restoration involving land-use and INVestigate the potential use of wastewater to create wildlife habitats or marshy areas
